

NOTTINGHAM VETERANS FENCING CLUB

RULES

1. The Club will respect all UK and EU legal requirements and operate according to the Constitution of the Club
2. The Club shall be affiliated to the National Governing body, (British Fencing Association) and shall abide by its rules and codes of conduct including Safeguarding and Data Protection.
3. Membership is open to all experienced fencers who are aged 39 or over on the year of joining, regardless of gender, religion, race, colour or national or ethnic origin.
4. Members shall, for the purposes of insurance, be individual members of the British Fencing Association and shall at all time abide by British Fencing Association codes of conduct.
5. Each member shall pay membership fees/session fees, which may be varied from time to time, as required for the efficient operation of the club for the benefit of its members, but which shall be agreed at a General Meeting of the Club membership.
6. Members shall not behave in any manner which might be detrimental to the club, be disrespectful to any members or officials of the club, British Fencing Association or any of its associated organisations, venue management and staff or any spectator or other members of the public.
7. Members shall when carrying out the actions in the sport of fencing ensure that their personal safety equipment and weapons are in good condition and are in accordance with the safety guidelines specified by British Fencing Association.
8. Members shall not engage in any fencing activity where an opponent is not properly protected by personal protective equipment as specified in the British Fencing Association guidelines.
